

How to Connect to VATSIM

Callsign – Type your airline call sign, AXX123 where 123 are the numbers assigned to you when you passed your Online Certification Check Ride.

Real Name – Your First and Last name

Server - IP of the server that you will be logging into

Port – 6809

ID – Your VATSIM ID (depending on which network you are logging into)

Password – Your VATSIM password (depending on which network you are logging into).

Model – Type the aircraft ICAO Code that you will be using (see the table above) and make sure that the drop-down menu contains the correct acf.

Airline - Type “AXX” in the Airline box for Alliance Airways

Livery – Select “Generic”.

If you are flying with the Flight School Aircraft (C172, P28A) or EZ Rocket (LGEZ)

Callsign – NAXxxx

xxx either being your assigned callsign (from when you passed the online check ride) or three numbers you want. For example my call sign is AXX8825. I would log in as **NAX825**

Online Connection Check List

	1. Run xplane and load your aircraft of choice.
	2. Place your aircraft at your airport of choice.
	3. Position the aircraft anywhere you like in the airport. Mak sure that you are not on any of the runways.
	4. Log into the VATSiM
	5. Enter your “call sign”
	6. Enter your “real name”
	7. Enter port 6809
	8. Enter your VATSIM ID
	9. Enter your VATSIM Password
	10. Enter your aircraft model ICAO code
	11. Enter the name of the VA you are flying under (if none, leave blank and go to step 13)
	12. Enter the aircraft livery that you are using.
	13. Click on “Connect”
